

Receive Tuition Assistance Through the Florida Resident Access Grant (FRAG)

FRAG was created by the Florida Legislature to provide tuition assistance to resident students attending eligible, nonprofit private colleges and universities located in the State of Florida. The program is administered by the Florida Department of Education pursuant to Florida Statutes and administrative rules adopted by the State Board of Education.

Students who choose to attend Hodges University may be eligible to receive FRAG to help pay for their educational expenses. FRAG is a grant that does not require repayment. FRAG is only awarded during the Fall and Winter semesters.



ELIGIBILITY

To receive FRAG, a student:

1. Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or a FRAG Application.
2. Must have continuously been a resident of Florida for other than educational purposes for one year immediately preceding the award of FRAG.
3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student (12 credit hours).
4. Must not have previously received a bachelor's degree.
5. Must be an eligible citizen or eligible noncitizen.
6. Must not owe a repayment of a grant under any state or federal grant or scholarship program.
7. Must not be in default on any state or federal student loan program unless satisfactory arrangements to repay have been made.

AWARD

Funds for FRAG are contingent each year upon the General Appropriations Act approved by the Florida Legislature. Depending on the availability of funds, FRAG may be reduced for the Winter semester.

RENEWAL

As a condition for renewal of FRAG, the recipient must have earned a minimum cumulative institutional grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Recipients must also have earned 12 credits if they received FRAG for one semester and 24 credits if they received FRAG for two semesters. Credit hours earned the previous Summer semester can be counted towards the total number of credit hours required. If a student fails to meet these requirements, they will lose eligibility for one year or until a 2.0 GPA is maintained. FRAG may be received for up to nine semesters or until receipt of a bachelor's degree, whichever comes first.
