

Tuition Assistance Is Available Through The Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG)

Students who choose to attend Hodges University may be eligible to receive FSAG to help pay for their educational expenses. FSAG is available to full-time, degree seeking undergraduate students who demonstrate substantial financial need. FSAG is a grant that does not require repayment. FSAG is only awarded during the Fall and Winter semesters.

ELIGIBILITY

To receive FSAG, a student:

1. Must submit a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to demonstrate financial need. The FAFSA must be submitted by the May 1 deadline. Please contact the Office of Student Financial Aid if you previously submitted a FAFSA.
2. Must have continuously been a resident of Florida for other than educational purposes for one year immediately preceding the award of FSAG.
3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student (12 credit hours).
4. Must not have previously received a bachelor's degree.
5. Must be an eligible citizen or eligible noncitizen.
6. Must not owe a repayment of a grant under any state or federal grant or scholarship program.
7. Must not be in default on any state or federal student loan program unless satisfactory arrangements to repay have been made.

AWARD

Funds for FSAG range from \$200 - \$1,500 per academic year and are contingent each year upon the General Appropriations Act approved by the Florida Legislature. FSAG is paid on a prorated basis at the beginning of each semester. Depending on the availability of funds, FSAG may be reduced for the Winter semester.

RENEWAL

As a condition for renewal of FSAG, the recipient must have earned a minimum cumulative institutional grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Recipients must also have earned 12 credits if they received FSAG for one semester and 24 credits if they received FSAG for two semesters. Credit hours earned the previous Summer semester can be counted toward the total number of credit hours required. If a student fails to meet these requirements, they will lose eligibility for one year or until a 2.0 GPA is maintained. FSAG may be received for up to nine semesters or until receipt of a bachelor's degree, whichever comes first.
