



**Personal Statement for MLS admission application and other requirements:**

To apply to the MLS program applicants must:

1. Provide a resume delineating all academic and work experience
2. Prepare a 350 minimum/1000 maximum personal statement. The prompt for this statement is:

"Please explain your professional goals and why you believe this Master degree will assist you in attaining those goals. Additionally, discuss how your background, work and educational experiences would contribute to your ability to succeed in the Legal Studies Master degree program."

3. Have a 30-minute interview with the chair of the department. This will be by Skype or in person if the student is local. The appointment can be scheduled during the day, evening, or weekend. Questions will address the student's interest in pursuing this degree.
