



ADMISSIONS PROCESS FOR THE BSN PROGRAM

A secondary program application process is undertaken by students to be admitted into the BSN nursing core. When students have completed at least thirty pre-nursing credits of the science and liberal arts courses, they are able to apply to the nursing core.

Criteria for admission to the nursing core includes:

- Complete a secondary Nursing Application
- A 2.50 GPA of all prerequisite courses required for the **BSN** program
- Grades of C or higher in all science courses
- A competitive score on the Test of Essential Academic Success (TEAS)
- Complete personal interview
- Complete essay
